Raising funds to replace 8 Patient Monitors located in the following critical care areas at a cost of €157,116.

- Emergency Department Resus
- St. Michael's C – Renal Transplant Monitoring
- CT – Anaesthetic machine monitoring room

Background:

- The average age of the eight monitors that need to be replaced is 12 years old.
- It will mean that all of the critical care monitors will be operating on the same platform and fully standardised.
- It will allow the patient data to move with the patient if they need to be transferred.
- Replacement of these monitors will allow the staff of Temple Street to deliver the best possible care to little patients who are treated in the hospital.

Benefits to the patient:

- Technology has improved great over the past 12 years and families can rest assured their children are being cared for by world leaders in patient monitoring.
- Seamless integration of patient data from Emergency Department into the ICU patient record system when a patient is transferred.
